

Notice of Race

The 2018 Cal 20 Canadian Championships – July 7th and 8th Hosted by the Kitsilano Yacht Club

Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the “ Rules “ as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020, the prescriptions of the CYA, The Rules of the California 20 Class (except as any of these are altered as set out below)

Eligibility : The Regatta is open to all yachts of the Cal 20 Class.
All yachts shall conform to the eligibility requirements of the notice of race and sailing instructions of the Kitsilano Yacht Club Invitational Regatta.

In addition to the notice of race and sailing instructions of the Kitsilano Yacht Club Invitational Regatta, and for the purposes of the Canadian Championships :

- A Cal 20 is eligible For the Canadian Championships providing it is owned by a member of a Cal 20 Fleet.
- A Class Measurement Certificate is optional. However, to be eligible for a first, second or third place trophy, a Cal must have or qualify for a valid Class Measurement Certificate upon that final day of racing if challenged. The cost to challenge and request a measurement of any placing yacht shall be \$100.00 CDN payable to the host Fleet and is refundable upon the non - qualification of the yacht being measured.
- Haul out after Saturdays racing shall be optional.

Prizes : The Canadian Cal 20 Championship Trophy

First, Second and Third overall keeper plaques.

All the above shall hereto form part of the sailing instructions that may be altered by way of the Skippers meeting held prior to racing as prescribed by The Kitsilano Yacht Club.
